# FRANCOPHONE AFRICA BOOTCAMP REPORT



## **NEED**

Francophone sub-Saharan Africa is witnessing exponential growth in the information and communications technology sector, and the signs are that it will continue and intensify in the years to come. By 2022 there will be 1 billion mobile connections in sub-Saharan Africa, generating almost USD 50 billion in total service revenue.

Francophone Africa experienced an economic growth rate of 4.9 percent in 2021 according to the World Bank's Global Economic Prospects report, higher than the 2.9 percent growth rate experienced by the rest of the continent. With their large youth populations, Ivory Coast, Burkina Faso, Senegal, and Guinea are some of the fastest-growing economies in the world. As these economies grow, the mobile penetration rate is growing as well.

For African countries to succeed in their digitization drives, they have to put in the right policies and train their people. They also need solid planning that can be adjusted along the way until they get to where they want to go. However, since 2019 when the discussion on digitization in Africa began in earnest, nothing much has been done. At the time it was said that digitization was the Fourth Industrial Revolution that Africa should not miss. But now there is a gap that needs to be filled.

To digitalize, we need talents, and talents, very unfortunately, don't grow on trees. We have to invest in them, train them and in our investment, we have to count on our domestic resources first before we go out looking for additional resources.





## **EVENT SUMMARY**







# ANSWERS FROM PATF TEAM ON COMMENTS AND REVIEWS FROM THE AUDIENCE

#### **Erwin N'Guetta:**

These are two different topics. Inflation comes from the monetary policy of countries which is different from the Blockchain which is a technology that would solve this problem


#### Ralph Nke:

The fundamental is already to make commercial actors integrate the concept of cryptocurrency, from the simple trader of apron to the largest industries, then to show them how their economy is secure (this is where the concept of CRYPTO in cryptocurrency comes in). Blockchain and more so cryptocurrencies guarantee confidentiality and transparency in the management of its economy, and I would go so far as to add that accounting is therefore facilitated.

Georges Magliore Foaleng Fokam: The buyer and the seller of the apron would have to agree to make bitcoin their currency. As for obviously considering the technical issues; as the platform dedicated to the operation. Cryptos are currencies like any other. It is their financial appreciation in the context of trade that gives them an exchange value. They cannot therefore be considered as a means of becoming rich.

Yazi Adamou: We need payment system

Alexandro Kolani: We cannot expect a real solution from our governments.
